Healthy Eating:

The Public Schools Branch mandates schools to encourage and maintain supportive environments which promote healthy food choices. Studies show sugary drinks and sweets have a negative impact on a child’s academic performance, learning and memory. As a result, we discourage drinks with high sugar or energy content, including caffeinated beverages (i.e. iced coffees); also, food that is high in calories from sugar, fat, and sodium but with little dietary fiber, protein or other forms of important nutritional value (i.e. candy, bars, chips, etc.) **With Halloween coming, it will be important to monitor what treats your child is taking and limit these coming to school.** As an alternative, we encourage servings of fresh fruit and vegetables.
