Day Camps:

About our camps: We invite you to an adventure-filled week exploring the many natural spaces in the park, making nature art, playing games, building forts, trying bushcraft challenges, learning about plants and animals, reading books from Sammy the squirrel, and making new friends! Our programs are founded on Forest School principles of child-led, inquiry-based experiences and free/unstructured play, with opportunities to try riskier outdoor activities under the supervision and support of our caring staff. We spend the whole day outside, rain or shine (except in dangerous weather)! At midday, we have lunch and a quiet time break where each camper gets their own hammock. We have access to an indoor washroom and water bottle refill station at Robert Cotton Park; in Summerside, we do not, so we will bring a camping toilet, privacy tent, and extra water and hand sanitizer.

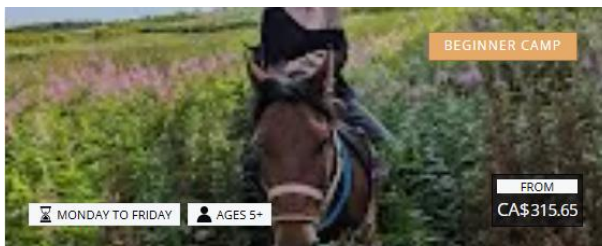
